## **SIXTH FORM SCHOOLWEAR**

- 1 Dark, single colour matching tailored suit (jacket with skirt, dress or trousers)  
[Dresses or skirts should be worn close to knee length and must not be made of Lycra or bodycon material]
- 5 Plain, single pale colour smart collared blouse or shirt & tie. No scoop necklines
- 1 Dark v neck jumper (optional)
- 1 Pair sturdy, flat, leather shoes (capable of being polished)  
No suede, nubuck, canvas, sports footwear, trainers which look like shoes, coloured laces or buckles or boots
- 5 Pairs tights (if skirt or dress is chosen)
- 5 Pairs socks (if trousers are chosen)  
An Academic House badge will be issued which must be worn on the jacket lapel

Discreet make-up and jewellery is permitted. No hoops or drop earrings

ALL items should be CLEARLY NAMED

ALL clothes must be clean, tidy and in a good state of repair

Official games clothing is required for sports

## **OWN CHOICE CLOTHING**

Casual clothing may be worn after the working day. Items of informal dress should be tasteful and appropriate to the occasion for which they are worn. Extremes of fashion are not acceptable. On occasions such as theatre visits, lectures, dances etc. formal clothing is worn.

On formal occasions boarders will be expected to wear smart clothes such as a dress, or tailored trousers/skirt, a blouse or shirt. Skirts and dresses should be below knee length
