#### 1<sup>ST</sup> - 5<sup>TH</sup> FORM <u>SCHOOLWEAR</u>

- 1 Regulation Navy polywool one button fitted jacket \* / Navy crested blazer \*
- 1 Regulation pleated skirt \*(below knee length) or
- Pair charcoal grey, tailored trousers (not skinny fit or jersey fabric)
- 5 Long sleeve cotton revere collar chambray blouses or shirts \*
- 1 Senior tie navy with royal stripe \* (if shirts are chosen)
- 2 Navy cotton acrylic V-neck jumper with royal stripe (optional) \*
- Pair sturdy, flat black leather shoes (capable of being polished)
  No suede, nubuck, canvas, sports footwear, trainers which look like shoes, coloured laces or buckles or boots
- 5 Pairs navy opaque tights (if skirt is chosen)
- 5 Pairs plain, dark socks (if trousers are chosen) all socks should be named
- 1 Warm and waterproof jacket or coat

Jewellery is not to be worn with School uniform except for discreet ear studs or similar in the ear lobes. Hoops or drop earrings must not be worn.

Discreet make up is permitted. Please note that if it is not discreet, wipes will be provided for its removal.

<u>ALL</u> items must be of the style and colour obtainable from Schoolblazer <u>ALL</u> items should be CLEARLY NAMED. Schoolblazer offer a name tagging service <u>ALL</u> clothes must be clean, tidy and in a good state of repair

#### **OWN CHOICE CLOTHING**

Casual clothing may be worn after the working day. Items of informal dress should be tasteful and appropriate to the occasion for which they are worn. Extremes of fashion are not acceptable. On occasions such as theatre visits, lectures, dances etc. formal clothing is worn.

On formal occasions boarders will be expected to wear smart clothes such as a dress or tailored trousers/skirt and blouse / suit or blazer. Skirts and dresses to be below knee length.
