We are looking for someone who has a relevant degree and strong subject knowledge, and who demonstrates excellence in the classroom with a proven track record of achieving good results. The successful candidate will communicate effectively with pupils, parents and colleagues, and will be highly organised, self-motivated and committed to meeting deadlines. They will be able to work well as part of a team, lead by example, and show empathy for the Quaker ethos of the school while always maintaining professionalism and confidentiality. Desirable experience includes involvement in extra-curricular activities, an understanding of safeguarding within a school that includes boarding, and experience working in an inclusive educational environment.
